We have some important information to share with you.

We have a couple of issues that we need to address before they become a big problem. The two issues are one, excessive barking when your dog/dogs are outside, which can be annoying. The other is the off-leash dogs.

Excessive barking

Everyone may address this needed training in any manner that you see fit to correct this behavior. But for what it is worth we reached out to a local dog expert who gave us a tip on how you can address any outside dog

that barks excessively. She stated that the most important approach to address this is that the homeowner must be outside with them. Once the barking starts the dog must be taught that this is not appropriate behavior. She said that you need to bring them back inside right away. Some trainers feel that you should gently cuff the nose at the same time and tell them NO. Eventually, they will get it. So no matter what training you implement, we are asking that this be addressed as soon as possible.

Off Leash

The final issue to resolve is dogs being allowed to be off-leach to roam the yard only to stray outside the property. They have been confronting people and other dogs who are not confrontable with that type of close contact, causing excessive anxiety. Unless you have the invisible fence we will be asking that if they are allowed to roam you must be out there with them.

Thank you for working with your four-legged family members in making this neighborhood a safer and quieter place to live.
